1. **Class 5:** 1" crushed gravel with 10% crushed rock and 4% clay
2. **Class 5 Modified:** 1" crushed gravel with 30% crushed rock and 12% clay
3. **Class 6:** 1" Crushed gravel with 50% crushed rock & 4% Clay
4. **Class 1:** ¾" Crushed gravel with 12% clay.
5. **¾" Crusher fines:** Driveway Material & Patio Block Base with dust to help compaction.
6. **¾" Washed Chips:** Driveway material no large rocks to plow in the winter.
7. **Pit Run Fill Sand:** beach sand or fill material has some rocks
8. **Beach Sand:** fine soft sugar sand for beach or playground no rocks
9. **Washed Sand:** floor heat, septic mound sand
10. **Pea Rock:** ¾" minus
11. **¾" Minus:** washed 100% round rock, drain tile.
12. **1" Round Landscape Rock.** Washed round rock for drain tile, landscape rock
13. **1" Crushed rock w/crusher dust:** driveways & parking lot material
14. **1" Dirty Rock:** soft roads, deep mud holes sets up hard
15. **1" Crushed Rock 100% Crushed:** driveways, parking lots, drain tile rock and in front of garages
16. **1 ¾" Crushed Rock:** landscape rock
17. **1 ¾" Dirty Rock:** soft roads, deep mud holes sets up hard
18. **1 ¾" Round landscape & Sewer Rock.** Landscape & drain field rock
19. **1 ¾" Rail Road Ballets:** 90% Crushed Rock for landscaping.
20. **2 – 4" Crushed Rock:** Landscaping Rock
21. **1 – 3" Round Landscape Rock.**
22. **2 – 4" Round Landscape Rock:**
23. **3 – 6" Round Landscape rock.**
24. **Class I Rip Rap. (2 – 9")** landscape, erosion problems
25. **Class II Rip Rap (4 – 12")** landscape, erosion problems
